Description of Course

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of early childhood education settings who work within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard. They support the implementation of an approved learning framework, and support children's wellbeing, learning and development. Depending on the setting, educators may work under direct supervision or autonomously.

Activities / Tasks

The course provides both theoretical and practical training that is linked directly to the work that early childhood education related employees undertake. The course includes:

- Practicing skills in a simulated real-life working environment;
- Developing an understanding and knowledge of child development and care;
- Learning about health and safety in the workplace; and
- An introduction to family, culture and diversity via both theory and practical components.

Assessment

Assessment is conducted using a combination of project based practical tasks, theory test and design folios/briefs. The assessment of your overall competence at this certificate level will be undertaken by a qualified assessor and your competence judge using all of these tasks. Students will be given a fair and adequate assessment process that include the option of an assessment re-sit.
